Dear Environmental Health Academic:

The International Environmental Health Faculty Forum (IEHFF) is now issuing this **Call for Abstracts of Papers**. The IEHFF will be held in conjunction with the IFEH 15th World Congress on Environmental Health hosted by the New Zealand Institute of Environmental Health. The Congress will take place at the SkyCity Conference Center in Auckland from 20 to 23 March 2018.

The IEHFF traditionally runs parallel to the World Congress and is a gathering of academics who are involved in the delivery of professional environmental health educational programmes. The Forum seeks to explore issues of relevance to academics in this field, to share ideas and build links between colleagues.

Ideas for topics addressed during the Forum might include:

- Teaching, and learning styles in environmental health;
- Assessment styles and strategies;
- Online education;
- Educational technologies;
- Professional practice overview and assessment of arrangements in various countries;
- Professional body/academic interface;
- International staff/student exchange;
- Future needs and developments in environmental health undergraduate education;
- Enrolment trends and programme promotion;
- Current and future career opportunities for environmental health graduates;
- Research in environmental health and its further development; or,
- MSc Environmental Health programmes– current and proposed, opportunities for collaboration. International dimensions .

Or, feel free to submit an abstract on another relevant educational topic.

Please note: As the Faculty Forum is for education-related topics, we are encouraging faculty to submit abstracts pertaining to their original Environmental Health research through the regular World Congress process.
