Review the literature and present an argument for environmental health practitioners (EHP) and their organisations to fully engage at the global and local community level in the "The Climate Change Challenge"... In your analysis identify and discuss relevant global policies and highlight the appropriate local environmental health policy/solutions/actions/partners/community engagement that is necessary to reduce the impacts of climate change.

FORMAT

A4 - pdf files, provide a Cover Page with Name and Title of Essay and your organization, provide a Table of Contents, List of Tables and Figures, List of Abbreviations, use standard margins, use Ariel 11 Font, use 1.5 line spacing, provide references (references in the Appendix not included in word count) and reference all work of others in the text using a "Harvard style" or similar consistent style.

JUDGING PANEL and AWARD

A panel of judges consisting of the IFEH President and the Regional Chairs will review the Essays and Presentations and select the Award Winner for the Roy Emerson Award.

The Winner will be notified of the Roy Emerson Award by 30 May 2014 by the IFEH President. The student will be funded by IFEH (Return Economy Airfare, Student Conference Registration and 4 nights' accommodation) to receive the prestigious Award in Las Vegas, USA and to present the Award Winning Essay as a 20 minute Conference Presentation at the joint 13th IFEH World Congress/NEHA AEC Event from 7-10 July 2014 in Las Vegas.
